Dress Code for each category:

- Baby, Tiny, Little & Petite Miss Categories Short Party Dress or Short Pageant Dress
- Young Miss Category Short Pageant Dress or Floor Length Dress
- Junior, Teen Miss Categories Floor Length Gown
(No strapless, no fully beaded or sequined, no tight or form fitting attire)
- Miss Category Formal Evening Gown
(Only the Miss Little River County category will be permitted to wear strapless and/or full sequined or beaded gowns. Cutouts are not recommended.)

DRESS CODES MUST BE FOLLOWED OR THE CONTESTANT MAY BE DISQUALIFIED

Photogenic category requirements:

- Photos must be less than one year old
- Photos do not have to be black and white
- Photo must be a headshot from the neck up
- Photo should depict a good face shot (hair away from face, no shadows, and no hands)
- Hats are acceptable
- 5X7 or larger are recommended but not required
- No blurry shots
- Photo should be a forward view with subject looking straight into the camera (no profiles, over the shoulder or shots from the back are recommended)
- No enhanced photos will be accepted

All rehearsals will be closed to the public.

*Only the contestant's parents or pageant coach will be allowed at rehearsals.
(Do not bring small children to the rehearsals, unless they are a contestant.)*

Rules and Regulations

In order for the pageant to run smoothly and be a success, everyone involved must follow the pageant rules. To eliminate any misunderstandings, the rules listed below must be strictly followed with no exceptions or the contestant may be disqualified and no entry fee refunds will be given if this occurs.

1. All contestants must reside or attend school in Little River County.
2. Contestant must have never been married or pregnant.
3. Contestants may re-enter a category, which they have previously won as long as one (1) year has passed.
4. All contestants are required to attend pageant rehearsal, which will be held at the Foreman High School Auditorium.
5. Each contestant will compete in their appropriate age category in appropriate attire which is outlined above and will be required to answer an on stage question (Little Miss and up). Photogenic competition is optional in each category. Dress codes **MUST** be followed or the contestant may be disqualified.
6. If an abundant number of contestants enter a category, the category may be split in order to allow each contestant a greater chance of winning. A split will be determined by the contestant's birthdays or, if this is not possible, by another method which will be decided by the Pageant Officials and will not be disputed.
7. A category must have at least three contestants in order for competition. If a category falls short of this required amount, the entrants will receive a full refund of their entry in this category only.
8. Each contestant will receive one (1) free admission ticket. These free admissions also include anyone who is helping the contestant to get ready (mothers, hairdressers, etc...). All others must pay an admission fee of \$4.00.
9. Once the contestant is dressed and ready, all parents or coaches are to go to the audience. Pageant officials will make sure the girls get to the proper place at the correct time. Exception: A parent of the Baby and Tiny Miss contestants will be required to stay with their contestant until their competition is completed.
10. No talking will be allowed back stage during the competition. Noise can be heard onstage and in the audience.
11. Dressing facilities will be provided. Your age category will be assigned a certain room to dress in. You must dress in your assigned room or come ready. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** If you are not in your assigned room, it will not be the responsibility of the Pageant Officials to find you when you are needed for competition and you will be disqualified.
12. Pageant Officials expect courtesy and respect. We encourage lady-like behavior and appropriate attire at all meetings, rehearsals and during the pageant. **NO PROFANITY WILL BE TOLERATED!**
13. The judges will be qualified and their decisions are final.
14. Winners will receive a crown, trophy & banner. Runners-up will receive a trophy. All contestants ages 5 and under will receive a participation award. Talent winners will receive a trophy.
15. All winners will be required to represent Little River County in future contests as requested. All winners will also be required to participate in the Little River County Fair Parade to be held on Tuesday, August 10th. The winners will provide their own cars and signs.
16. Little Miss Little River County 2010 will represent the county at the Southwest District Fair Contest in Hope, AR in September.
17. Miss Little River County 2010 and Little River County Senior Talent Winner 2010 will represent the county at the Southwest District Fair Contest in Hope, AR in September and at the Arkansas State Fair Queen & Talent Contest at Little Rock in October.
18. If the winner of any category cannot fulfill the responsibility and duties of that category due to family relocation, failure to comply with obligations, marriage or pregnancy, then the first runner up will assume the title and complete the year as the winner.
19. Pageant Officials, Foreman High School, or the Little River County Fair Association will not be responsible for injury or lost articles during the rehearsal, pageant or parade.
20. Entry fees will not be returned if contestant has to drop out.
