## PARADE LINE-UP

All entries are asked to assemble by 5:15 p.m. at the following locations. A parade committee member, wearing identification, will give you your number and line-up place.

- Walkers and Religious entries will line up on Schuman Street by Memorial Medical Clinic.
- Non-Commercial and Pageant entries will line up on 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue in front of Memorial Medical Clinic.
- Antique Automobiles, Car Clubs, & Commercial entries will line up on 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue across from Memorial Medical Clinic. Autos will be in front of Commercial entries.
- 4-wheelers, etc. entries will line up on Schuman St in front of Madden Funeral Home in front of the Foreman Fire truck.
- Tractors will line up on 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue on the west side of Schuman Street.
- Horses will line up on Schuman Street in behind the Fire Truck with Santa.

The Parade route will be: South down Schuman Street, left onto First Avenue, and left onto Bell Street ending at the First Assembly of God Church. <u>Please return to the Foreman Community Center</u> following parade for trophy presentations.

We strongly encourage participants to line up by 5:15 or as early as possible.

## **RULES**

- 1. All businesses and organizations are invited to enter the Christmas Parade as long as the theme is portrayed. **NO ENTRY SHALL HAVE A LIVE SANTA.**
- 2. Throwing of candy <u>will be</u> permitted. Candy must be store bought and wrapped. Santa will also throw candy at the end of the parade. After the parade Santa will be at the Foreman Community Center. Children may bring letters to him at that time and visit with him.
- 3. Entrant of horses will be allowed only with a current negative Coggins test. Horses will line up behind Santa on the fire truck.
- 4. Four wheelers & motorcycles must be decorated & have line-up number. There will be NO breaking out of line or unsafe driving.
- 5. Pageant winners and Homecoming Queens may ride on individual automobile or float. If riding on a float, float must be decorated with the theme of the parade.
- 6. All entrants **must** complete entire parade route.
- 7. Entries will be notified of their entry number after the parade line-up is complete.
- 8. Each entry must know their line-up number.
- 9. The parade winners will be determined by a panel of judges selected by the parade committee and located on the judges' stand between the Foreman Library and Foreman Community Center. The parade route will continue south on Schuman Street, left onto First Avenue and left onto Bell Street. Judges' selections are based on the following score card:

Application to the theme of parade	10 Points
Originality	20 Points
Neatness and Attractiveness	10 Points
Quality and Completeness	10 Points

- 10. Judges' decisions are final.
- 11. Awards will be presented the night of the parade. Entrants should report back to Foreman Community Center to receive award.
- 12. Entrants must fill out pages 1 & 2 for the announcer, who will be on judges' stand announcing the floats and describing them. Please stop at the judges' stand long enough for the announcer to read your information.
- 13. Awards will be given in the following categories:

Religious	First	Second

Antique Automobiles	First	Second
Other Motorized Vehicles	First
