PARADE LINE-UP

All entries are asked to assemble by 6:00 p.m. at the following locations. A parade committee member, wearing identification, will give you your number and line-up place.

The Parade route will be: From Memorial Clinic (formerly Regions Bank) on 3rd Ave South onto N. Schuman Street, left onto 1st Avenue, right onto Bell Street, turn left again on Boswell Ave by Livestock Nutrition (gravel road) ending at the LRC Fair Barn. <u>The announcer & judges will be at the corner of Schuman St. and 1st Avenue (Gazebo).</u>

We strongly encourage participants to line up by 6:00pm.

RULES

1. All businesses and organizations are invited to enter the LRC Fair & Rodeo Parade as long as the theme is portrayed.

2. Throwing of candy <u>will be</u> permitted. Candy must be store bought and wrapped.

3. Entrant of horses will be allowed, although owners will need to provide proper papers (Negative Coggins) before being allowed to enter the parade. Horses will proceed before the fire truck.

4. All entries must be on the official entry form and received by the final due date of August 19th, to be eligible for awards.

5. Four wheelers & motorcycles <u>must</u> be decorated & have line-up number. There will be <u>NO</u> breaking out of line or unsafe driving.

6. Pageant winners and Homecoming Queens may ride on individual automobile or float. If riding on a float, float must be decorated with the theme of the parade.

7. All entrants **<u>must</u>** complete entire parade route.

8. Entries will be notified of their entry number after the parade line-up is complete.

9. Each entry must know their line-up number.

10. The parade winners will be determined by a panel of judges selected by the parade committee and located at the gazebo. Judges' selections are based on the following score card:

Application to the theme of parade	40 Points
Originality	20 Points
Neatness and Attractiveness	20 Points
Quality and Completeness	20 Points

11. Judges' decisions are final.

12. Awards will be presented the night of the parade. Entrants should report back to LRC Fair Barn to receive award.

13. Entrants must fill out pages 1 & 2 for the announcer, who will be on judges' stand. Announcing the floats and describing them.

14. Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd, & 3rd places:

15. Any questions or decisions not covered in the above rules will be determined by the parade chairperson or committee.
