The mayor gave a report on the damage from the Ice/snowstorm on various city properties. Claims have been filed on them.

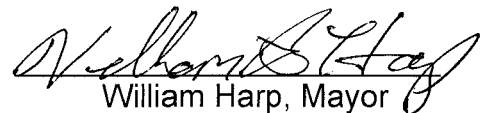
Council member Wiseman informed everyone that the Black History Parade is set for February 21st at 9:00 am.
