

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE COUNCIL
OF FOREMAN, ARKANSAS
June 15, 2026**

The City Council of Foreman, Arkansas met in regular session June 15th, 2026, in the Foreman Community Center. The following were present: Mayor Bill Harp, Council members Alana Cody, Tommy McDonald, Joe Green, Mike McKee, Treasurer Kristan Chapa, Recorder Michelle Harp.

CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Harp, followed by prayer from Council Member Mike McKee. This was followed by the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance.

REVIEW & APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

The May minutes were reviewed and approved by the Council with a motion by Cody and seconded by Joe Green. Motion carried.

REVIEW & APPROVAL OF FINANCIALS:

The financials for May were reviewed and approved by the Council with a motion by McKee and seconded by Cody. Motion Carried.

CITIZEN'S COMMENTS:

Chad Cauley presented his proposal to purchase the Parts House and is requesting the city to help with the purchase using IDC funds.

OLD BUSINESS:

Forrest Vertz gave an update on his request for the city to vacate an easement. A motion to table the issue was made by McKee and seconded by Joe Green. Motion carried.

No new updates on the chain link fence at sewer pond and at the yard/park. ,

NEW BUSINESS:

The mayor presented a request to close the Water Operating account, Meter Deposit account, and credit cards that are currently at Regions Bank. And open a Water Operating account, Meter Deposit account, and credit card accounts at Farmers Bank & Trust. The administrator of all the accounts will be Mayor Bill Harp. The signers on the bank accounts will be Bill Harp, Kristan Chapa, and Courtney Mauger. The credit cards will be issued to Mayor Harp and Kristan Chapa with a limit of not more than \$25000.00. A credit card will also be issued to the water superintendent, Dakota Bushey, and to the Fire Department. Both with a limit of not more than \$2000.00. Motion made by McKee and seconded by Cody. Motion carried.

INDIVIDUAL ANNOUNCEMENTS:

The district water meeting will be held in Foreman on June 25, 2026, at 6:00 pm.

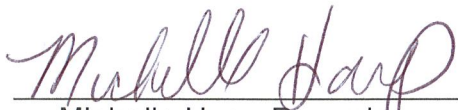
Park Director McDonald advised the council that he will be moving the Kiwana's food box from the old park to the senior center.

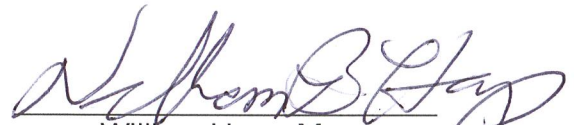
Council member McKee informed the council of the passing of Jacqueline Wiseman.
