Ashley announced that she would be leaving and that the city is looking for a replacement for the Treasurers' position.

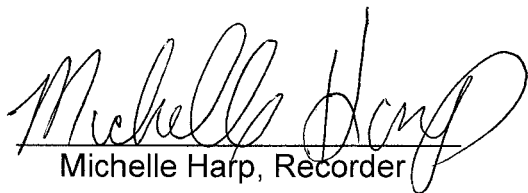
Dakota advised the council that one of the mowers was broken.
